



SETON CATHOLIC SCHOOL COMMUNICATIONS, FACILITIES, AND FUNDRAISING POLICY

Seton Catholic School's 410 students come to us from more than 260 families, and represent more than 20 different Northeast Ohio communities and more than 24 different parishes and congregations.

Seton families are passionately involved in supporting both the school and a number of additional endeavors in the region. These outside interests include, but are not limited to, various clubs, boy scouts, girl scouts, faith-based programs, athletic organizations, and cultural dance programs.

Almost daily, individuals and groups seek to use the school's communication channels, resources, and facilities to promote non-Seton fundraisers and events.

It is due to the volume of these requests and our critical need to focus on programs most beneficial to the purpose of the school and our specific need for financial support that the following policy is announced:

"Seton Catholic School will use its resources, communication channels, and facilities to accommodate and promote only school functions as approved by the Board of Directors."

"Resources" are defined as school funds, school personnel, school-owned equipment, and postage.

"Communication channels" are defined as print and electronic media controlled by the school, email addresses, eAlerts, eConnect, SetonNotes, mailing addresses, mailings and printed pieces sent home from school with students.

"Facilities" are defined as the Seton Catholic School campus, parking lot, fields, and buildings.

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
