### Student Mask Policy

The CDC suggests that all school reopening plans address adherence to behaviors that prevent the spread of COVID-19. When used consistently and correctly, important mitigation strategies - cloth face coverings - are important to help slow the spread of COVID-19.

Most importantly, masks should follow CDC guidelines and be worn correctly by students. Masks provide an important layer of protection for our students and staff. In keeping with uniform accessories, masks should coordinate with the uniform. Masks must not contain slogans and must be appropriate for school. No bandanas, scarves, gaitors, or buffs. *The final decision regarding the appropriateness of masks and other dress code items will be at the discretion of the teacher and/or the administration.* It is recommended that a student always have a backup mask on campus. The wearing of masks along with good hand hygiene and distancing are the best known ways to prevent the spread of the virus.
